Tuesday, November 15: St. Albert the Great, Bishop

Albert was from Swabia. He was a master of philosophy, theology and the natural sciences, especially Aristotle. St. Thomas Aquinas was a student of his. He was Provincial of the German Dominicans (1254-1257), becoming bishop of Regensburg. A prolific writer, he has 38 quarto volumes in print. He wrote on the cult of the Sacred Heart and is the patron of scientists. He died in 1280 at Cologne.

Wednesday, November 16: St. Margaret of Scotland; St. Gertrude, Virgin

Margaret was from Hungary. A wife of King Malcolm III of Scotland and mother of eight, she helped root out paganism. Her love for the poor became legendary. She is the patroness of Scotland. She died in 1093.

Gertrude, called "the Great" was born in Thuringia. A Benedictine mystic of the famous Benedictine abbey of Helfta in Saxony, she wrote on the meaning of suffering, the Sacred Heart, the Trinity, and God's love. Her most important work was *Legatus Memorialis Abundantiae Divinae Pietatis (The Herald of Divine Love)*. She died November 17, 1301.

Thursday, November 17: St. Elizabeth of Hungary

Elizabeth was wife of Louis VI of Thuringia and mother of three. As a widow, she became a Franciscan tertiary and was dedicated to the needs of the poor and the sick. She died in 1231 at the age of 23. She was canonized only four years after her death. She is the patroness of the Franciscan Third Order and of Catholic charities.

Friday, November 18: The Dedication of the Basilicas of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles; St. Rose Philippine Duchesne, Virgin

Rose Philippine Duchesne was from Grenoble, France. She founded the first American house of the Religious of the Sacred Heart and opened the first American free school west of the Mississippi. She was known for her courage and desire to serve the indigenous peoples of the Americas esp., the Potawatomi who called her "the woman who prays always." She died in 1852 at age 83 at St. Charles, Missouri.
