It strengthens the resolve to resist temptations and to overcome obstacles in the moral life. The virtue of fortitude enables one to conquer fear, even fear of death, and to face trials and persecutions. It disposes one even to renounce and sacrifice his life in defense of a just cause. "The Lord is my strength and my song." "In the world you have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world." (CCC 1808)

Nothing was more important to humanity than God sending His only begotten Son, Jesus, to free us from the burden of sin. In the sixth century before the Christ, God promised a "New Covenant" through the prophet Jeremiah.

We hear Paul in today's Second Reading refer to this. In God's time, Jesus came. He taught, preached, suffered, and died to establish this New Covenant. Jesus later ascended back to the Father and sent His Holy Spirit on Pentecost.

All that was incredible—yet the most lasting, visible effect of all Jesus did for us is presented in today's Gospel: Jesus giving us His very Body and Blood for us to celebrate always in His memory. Think about Jesus' promise fulfilled each time as you walk to communion. Discuss this mystery with your children. Offer your testimony to your grown children. How does receiving Jesus in the Eucharist impact your life?
