The Cardinal Virtues

Temperance is the moral virtue that moderates the attraction of pleasures and provides balance in the use of created goods. It ensures the will's mastery over instincts and keeps desires within the limits of what is honorable. The temperate person directs the sensitive appetites toward what is good and maintains a healthy discretion: "Do not follow your inclination and strength, walking according to the desires of your heart." Temperance is often praised in the Old Testament: "Do not follow your base desires, but restrain your appetites." In the New Testament it is called "moderation" or "sobriety." We ought to live sober, upright, and godly lives in this world. (CCC 1809)

Paul tells us in today's Second Reading that, "We (Christians) are not discouraged...our inner self is being renewed each day." How can we be renewed and virtually never be discouraged? Matthew Kelly has the answer in his book coming in August 2018. Cast Holy Moments throughout our day. "A Holy Moment" is a moment open yourself to God. You make yourself available to him. You set aside what you feel like doing in that moment, and you set aside self-interest, and for one moment you simply do what you prayerfully believe God is calling you to do in that moment. That is a Holy Moment." For me, the key is turning to prayer and seeking God's will. Trick is I must set aside my own selfish approach. God's way is always better. I simply cannot be discouraged when I am living in God's will. Try it.

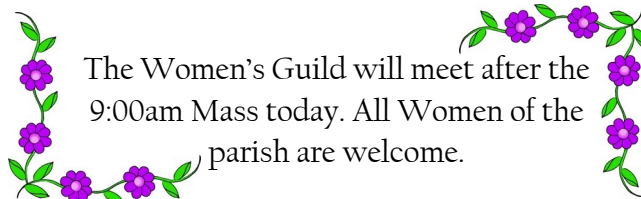

Commemorate Religious Freedom Week June 22-29

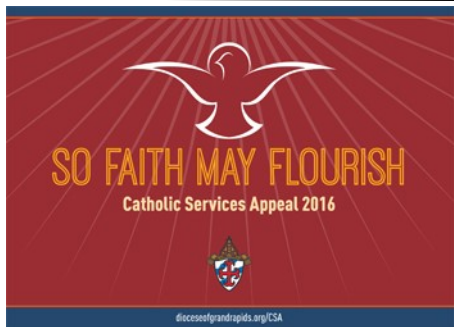
