Eucharistic Adoration with Praise and Worship Music

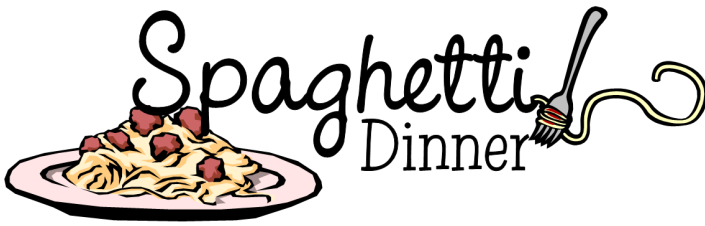
