Discern means "to come to know". *Disciples discern actions God's wisdom for daily life.* Just this week, we discerned which candidates for public office would best lead us to achieve a just, fair, and principled society. The widows in today's readings from the First Book of Kings and from Mark are examples of discerning. The non-Jewish widow willing shared a last meal with her son and the prophet Elijah. She trusted in Elijah and in the God of Israel. The all-giving widow of the Gospel was, perhaps, unjustly influenced by the well-dressed scribes who Jesus said would "devour the houses of widows." *Discern, using prayer, Scripture, Church teachings, and reflection.* Perhaps some actions concerning family matters could be discerned with parents and children. Be guided by the wisdom of the Holy Spirit.

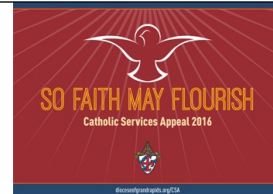
