“The Beatitudes are at the heart of Jesus’ preaching. They take up the promises made to the chosen people since Abraham. The Beatitudes fulfill the promises by ordering them no longer merely to the possession of a territory, but to the Kingdom of heaven...The Beatitudes depict the countenance of Jesus Christ and portray his charity. They express the vocation of the faithful associated with the glory of his Passion and Resurrection; they shed light on the actions and attitudes characteristic of the Christian life; they are the paradoxical promises that sustain hope in the midst of tribulations; they proclaim the blessings and rewards already secured, however dimly, for Christ’s disciples; they have begun in the lives of the Virgin Mary and all the saints.” (CCC 1716-1717)

The Grand Rapids Diocesan Council of Catholic Women is sponsoring a one day bus trip to the Shrine of Christ's Passion.

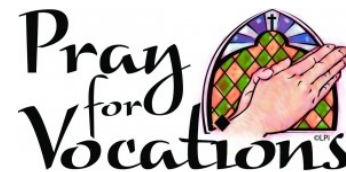
Cost is \$77 per person, and includes transportation, coffee and rolls, tours of the Shrine and St. John's church, and lunch.
