Today's Gospel is about *Sin, Justice, Mercy*, and *Repentance*. Jewish leaders apprehend a woman caught in adultery. Punishment under laws of Moses is death to the woman. (No mention of the man.) They bring the woman to Jesus. Jesus proves He is an *all-knowing God, with human compassion*.

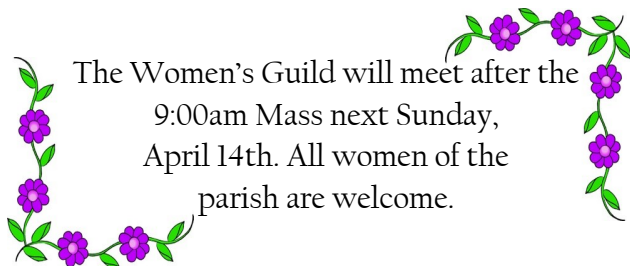
Jesus confronts the sin of the woman with the sin of the Jewish leaders. To the Scribes and Pharisees, Jesus simply says, "Let he who is without sin cast the first stone." (*Sin and Justice*) To the woman, Jesus says, "Neither do I condemn you. Go and sin no more." (*Mercy, and Repentance*) We, like the woman, are sinners. We, like the Jewish leaders, are judgmental. Jesus is calling us, today, to sin no more, to repent, and to be compassionate. How can we do this within our families?

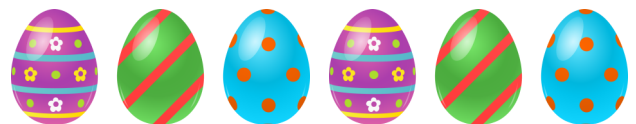
