Jesus died in a bloody, cruel manner. Why? 1) Hebrew Scripture provided for a bloody sacrifice of a perfect lamb to atone for sin. God promised in Jeremiah 31:31 a *New Covenant* that could not be broken by God's people. ***Jesus, the absolutely perfect Lamb of God, established that by his death on the Cross*** and atoned for the sins of many, including of ours. 2) ***Jesus did what was pleasing to the Father*** (John 8:29); the Father acknowledged that Jesus was His "beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased (Matthew 3:17)." 3) Crucifixion was the *Roman Empire's method of execution*. 4) ***Jesus' martyrdom served as a model*** for people over the centuries who would die, and are dying, for the faith. 5) We suffer in this life; we have the opportunity to ***unite our sufferings*** with those of Jesus, making Him our compassionate companion.

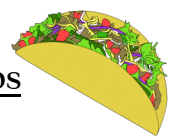

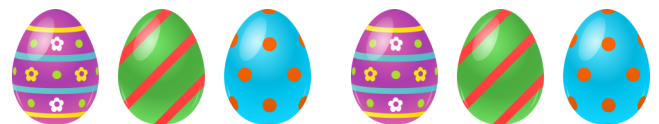
