“I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy.”

A plenary indulgence may be obtained by fulfilling these requirements:

- go to Confession (does not have to be on Divine Mercy Sunday)
- perform the indulgenced work (see below)
- say a prayer for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff (the Pope)

The Work for this Specific Indulgence, performed on Divine Mercy Sunday:

-in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament, exposed or reserved in the tabernacle, recite the Our Father, the Creed, and a devout prayer to the merciful Lord Jesus (e.g. “Merciful Jesus, I trust in you!”)

-or, in any church or chapel, in a spirit that is completely detached from the affection for sin, even venial sin, take part in the prayers and devotions held in honor of Divine Mercy

### Evangelization Clip by Deacon Jim Schiltz

Jesus’ Resurrection was the greatest game-changer in the history of the world! We, too, will rise upon the Second Coming of Jesus. That’s a good reason to be one of God’s faithful. A question: Are you happy with your life? What would you want to change? Are you making a difference in your world? Three benefits to being a committed Catholic: 1) the wisdom of the Holy Spirit, coupled with receiving Jesus in the Eucharist, guides your life; 2) opportunities to help people abound, such as helping to feed the hungry; and 3) You will have a faith to pass on to your children and grandchildren at a time when faith in God is desperately needed. So, will you be here next Sunday? And the Sunday after that? What is your commitment to God? How can God in your life make you a better person?

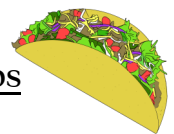

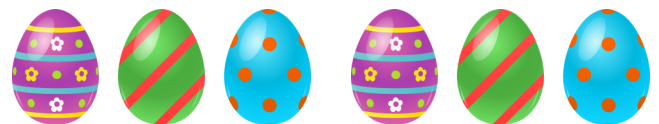
