**Evangelization Clip**

In today’s Gospel, the three-fold exchange between Jesus and Peter has an added dimension when read in Spanish. In both languages, Jesus twice asks Peter, “Do you *love* me?” But both Peter’s responses, translated from Spanish, is “You know I *like* you.” *Love*, of course, is a deeper commitment than “*like*”. Peter was not “there” yet. So the third time, Jesus simply asked, “Peter, do you *like* me?” And Peter said, “Yes, I *like* you.” *Jesus met Peter where Peter was at*. After Pentecost, the depth of Peter’s love and service was profound. He was the first Pope and he was martyred. So, do you *love* Jesus? Or are you still at the “*like*” stage? With deeper commitment, our “*like*” turns to *love*. And remember, Jesus *loves* us.
