Jesus tells us today that “the Spirit of truth will guide you to all truth...He will declare it to you.” God’s truths are absolute. Those truths are found in Scripture and in significant teachings of the Catholic Church. Such an *absolute truth is our God-given right to life*. No political party and no judicial body has greater authority than God. See Isaiah 49:15-16: “*Can a mother forget her infant, be without tenderness for the child of her womb? Even should she forget, I will never forget you. See, upon the palms of my hands I have engraved you.*”). In *Human Life and Dignity* (see USCCB), our bishops reference Pope Benedict’s Encyclical Letter, *Charity in Truth*, and state, “*As a gift from God, every human life is sacred from conception to natural death.*” We must form our consciences on such absolute truths. What could be better than life? Pass it on.

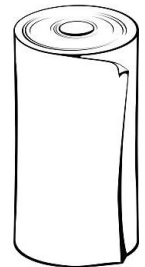
Knights of Columbus News:
