Second Sunday of Lent Time

Imagine this. Jesus is seated in the front pew. He stands in front in you. Suddenly, "His face shone like the sun and his clothes became white as light...a voice from above said, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him." When the three disciples heard this, they fell prostrate and were very much afraid." What would your reaction be? I would be in a state of disbelief, amazed, fearful, wondering, "What am I to do now?" What about you? Later in this hour, your will receive this same Jesus, His very Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity, in the Eucharist. So what are you to do now? So, talk to God! Imagine Jesus sitting next to you, smiling, looking into your eyes, listening to you with love. Speak to Him as a brother. Be vulnerable. Praise and thank Him. Pass on your faith to your children of all ages.
