EVANGELIZATION CLIP BY DEACON JIM SCHILTZ

On this Pentecost Sunday, ask the Holy Spirit to guide your Interior Life, which is a life with Jesus in our souls in our daily lives. Jesus was all about Faith, Hope, and Charity. We grow in those virtues through prayer, especially morning prayer, in the Sacraments, especially in this Eucharistic celebration, and in avoiding sin. This Interior Life, begun in Baptism by the state of grace, perfected at Confirmation, recovered by Penance, and enriched by the Eucharist, is our Christian life. My outward acts become the manifestation of this life of Jesus in me. This happens through grace, through God in our lives. Interestingly, our Faith, Hope, and Charity grow within me as I practice those virtues for the good of God's people, beginning with our family and friends. The end result is Jesus being my light, my ideal, my counsel and support, my refuge and strength, my healer and consoler, my joy, my love—and in a word, my life.

En este domingo de Pentecostés, pide al Espíritu Santo que guíe tu Vida Interior, que es una vida con Jesús en nuestras almas en nuestra vida diaria. Jesús tenía que ver con la fe, la esperanza y la caridad. Creemos en esas virtudes a través de la oración, especialmente la oración de la mañana, en los Sacramentos, especialmente en esta celebración eucarística, y evitando el pecado. Esta Vida Interior, iniciada en el Bautismo por el estado de gracia, perfeccionada en la Confirmación, recuperada por la Penitencia y enriquecida por la Eucaristía, es nuestra vida cristiana. Mis actos externos se convierten en la manifestación de esta vida de Jesús en mí. Esto sucede por gracia, por Dios en nuestras vidas. Curiosamente, nuestra fe, esperanza y caridad crecen dentro de mí a medida que practico esas virtudes para el bien del pueblo de Dios, comenzando por nuestros familiares y amigos. El resultado final es que Jesús es mi luz, mi ideal, mi consejo y apoyo, mi refugio y fortaleza, mi sanador y consolador, mi alegría, mi amor—y, en una palabra, mi vida.
