THEOLOGY ON TAP: "THE WORK OF OUR REDEMPTION: ACTIVE PARTICIPATION IN THE MASS", WITH AARON SANDERS Thursday, February 20th, 7pm at the former Old Hennessy's Pub While it is well known that the Church calls all the faithful to "fully conscious and active participation in liturgical celebrations," a typical emphasis on outward methods of participation (singing, responding, kneeling) risks falling short of the reality in which we participate. If, as the Second Vatican Council teaches, every liturgy is "an exercise of the priestly office of Jesus Christ" "through which the work of our redemption is accomplished," any true participation in Mass cooperates in the salvation of the world. In determining how best to join in this eternal work, we should be less concerned with what we get out of Mass than with what we can contribute to the Sacrifice.

Aaron Sanders is Director of the Office for Worship in the Diocese of Grand Rapids. He holds a Ph.D. in Theology from the University of Notre Dame and lives in Grand Rapids with his wife and nine children.

"Hope in the Truth of Beauty" Presented by Dr. Benjamin G. Lockerd Feb. 28, 7 – 9 p.m., Donnelly Center at Aquinas College

Philosophers have long considered three subjects of contemplation to be paramount: the True, the Good, and the Beautiful—called the Transcendentals. All three of these are considered by many people today purely relativistic concepts, and one of the goals of the Catholic educator must be to contradict the prevailing relativism. Of the three, beauty is often thought to be the most subjective, for "beauty is in the eye of the beholder." There is some truth to this old saying, but it is not the whole truth. Great thinkers have over the ages argued that beautiful creations have some characteristics in common. Advocates of literary art have further maintained that beautiful writings are effective in moving our hearts to follow truth and to do what is good. We should find profound hope in fact that the imagination can capture great truths of the human heart and move us to live virtuously.

A Vatican II document entitled Joys and Hopes (paragraph 48) tells us that the intimate partnership of married life and love has been established by the Creator and governed by His laws. The couple administers the Sacrament of Matrimony. Their Consent is irrevocable and life-long. The couple is fortified for life with the Rite's Nuptial Blessing imparted by the priest or deacon. God instituted matrimony for the conjugal love that procreates and later educates children. With their parents leading the way by example and family prayer, children receive a path to human maturity, salvation and holiness. Christ the Lord abundantly blesses marital love, which models His love and union with His Church. Children contribute to making their parents holy. They respond to the kindness of their parents with sentiments of gratitude, with love and trust. They will stand by them, as children should, when hardships overtake their parents and with the onset of their senior years. Today we celebrate marriage and family life. And pass it on.
